Hill SS Class	Toiletries: toothbrushes, tooth paste, floss, mouthwash, soap, shampoo, deodorant, Feminine hygiene products
Children's SS Classes	Food: canned goods, Vienna Sausages, cereal, Pop Tarts, macaroni & cheese, chips, crackers, snack bars, powdered drink mixes. NO WATER.
All Stars	Food: canned goods, Vienna Sausages, cereal, Pop Tarts, macaroni & cheese, chips, crackers, snack bars, powdered drink mixes. NO WATER.
Middle & High School SS Classes	First Aid items: Band-Aids, aspirin, Neosporin, peroxide
Youth Group	First Aid items: Band-Aids, aspirin, Neosporin, peroxide
MDO	Baby items: diapers, wipes, shampoo, lotion, body wash, formula, baby food, bottles
Worship Service	Food: canned goods, Vienna Sausages, cereal, Pop Tarts, macaroni & cheese, chips, crackers, snack bars, powdered drink mixes. NO WATER. Novels, Bibles
